Day 1: Tuesday, January 15, 2019 San Jose, Costa Rica - Tour Begins

Here, dedicated scientists are working to protect the turtle's nesting habitat and eggs. This evening, join

Day 3: Thursday, January 17, 2019 Tortuguero National Park Get your camera ready. Set out on an early morning bird-watching excursion* that explores the myriad of local and migratory birds that flock to this area. Next, embark on a nature cruise through the park - keep an eye out for howler monkeys, sloths, toucans and caimans. Tortuguero National Park, a study in biology, protects over 350 species of birds and mammals. Savor time to seek out green macaws and some of Costa Rica's endangered animals, including jaguars, tapirs, ocelots, cougars, river otters and even manatees. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Friday, January 18, 2019 Tortuguero National Park - Sarapiquí Take to the water again and embark on a leisurely boat ride to the mainland as we travel to the Sarapiquí region, one of the world's most important research regions for tropical rainforests. Visit an organic pineapple plantation to learn about the various types of this exotic fruit and taste why Costa Rican pineapples are among the world's best. Arrive at your eco-lodge nestled in the rainforest and surrounded by towering Almendro trees, howler monkeys and keel billed toucans. Enjoy free time to hike through the deep green forest or simply relax in a hammock and take in the nature around you. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Saturday, January 19, 2019 Sarapiquí Discover the history and continuing importance of cacao to Central America's economy when you visit a cacao plantation. Observe the process of producing chocolate from the cacao bean and sample the delicious finished product. Then, see the region from a different perspective on an exhilarating Sarapiquí River rafting adventure. Return to your rainforest lodge for a traditional Costa Rican dinner. (B, D)

Day 6: Sunday, January 20, 2019
Sarapiquí - Arenal Volcano Begin the day engulfed in nature with an early morning bird watching tour along the natural forest trails and nearby stream. Later, behold the spectacular views of Arenal Volcano and absorb the tranquility of your surroundings as you begin a 3-night stay at your resort featuring panoramic views of the volcano. (B)

View waterfowl, iguanas, and over fifty varieties of native birds, including the very rare scarlet macaw. Later we continue to the world-renowned Manuel Antonio National Park to check into our resort just outside the park. Soak up the sweeping views and take in the sunset overlooking the park and the Pacific Ocean before dining this evening. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Thursday, January 24, 2019 Manuel Antonio National Park Wake up to a cool breeze and spectacular views. The day is yours to relax and enjoy the surrounding beauty. You can enjoy the luxurious amenities of your resort, walk the nearby nature trails that lead to dramatic views of the Pacific, or perhaps head to the nearby white sand beaches. (*B*)

Manuel Antonio National Park - San
Jose This morning we explore
spectacular Manuel Antonio
National Park, known for its pristine
beaches and primary forest. Spend
your time walking the forest trails in
search of the three-toed sloth, agoutis,
squirrel monkeys and iguanas; or take
a swim in the inviting blue waters.
Then, say goodbye to the coast and
continue to San Jose and toast to the
natural richness that is Costa Rica at a
wonderful farewell dinner. (B, D)

Experience It! Tortuguero National Park

Located on the Caribbean Coast, this remote national park (accessible only by boat or airplane) is one of Costa Rica's most popular ecotourism destinations. Tortuguero — which translates to "region of turtles" in Spanish — is the most important nesting site of the green sea turtle. Four of the world's eight species of green sea turtles call Tortuguero their home including the Leatherback, Olive Ridley, Loggerhead and Hawksbill turtles. With over twenty miles of coastline and over 46,000 protected acres, the park is also home to a variety of animal species including jaguars, reptiles, macaws and over 300 species of birds. Wildlife and nature is abundant in this biologically diverse park consisting of a variety of habitats including rainforest, mangrove forests, swamps, beaches and lagoons. Your lodging at the edge of the park offers environmentally friendly accommodations and a network of rainforest trails throughout the property. Here you are able to relax in comfort while being in complete harmony with nature.

Please Note:

Taxes/fees to be paid in local currency or USD upon exiting the country are approximately \$32 USD per person.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

Smaller buses, which may not be lavatory equipped, may be used on this program. In this case, frequent stops are made during travel periods.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected with observance of religious or local holidays.

Feel the pure adrenaline and excitement of flying up to 35 miles per hour, viewing magnificent landscapes and scenic views. Zip lines, ranging from 120 feet to more than 2,000 feet in length and 60 - 400 feet in height, let you experience Manuel Antonio's rainforest from a whole new perspective. The tree top canopy tour not only offers a great adventure but also an opportunity to observe wildlife in its natural habitat. At the observation platform you have the chance to observe the surrounding forest, jungle and Pacific coast. Transportation & specialized personnel (accredited by the Costa Rica Tourism Board (ICT) accompany you throughout the tour. All guides and equipment used are certified by ICT.
