

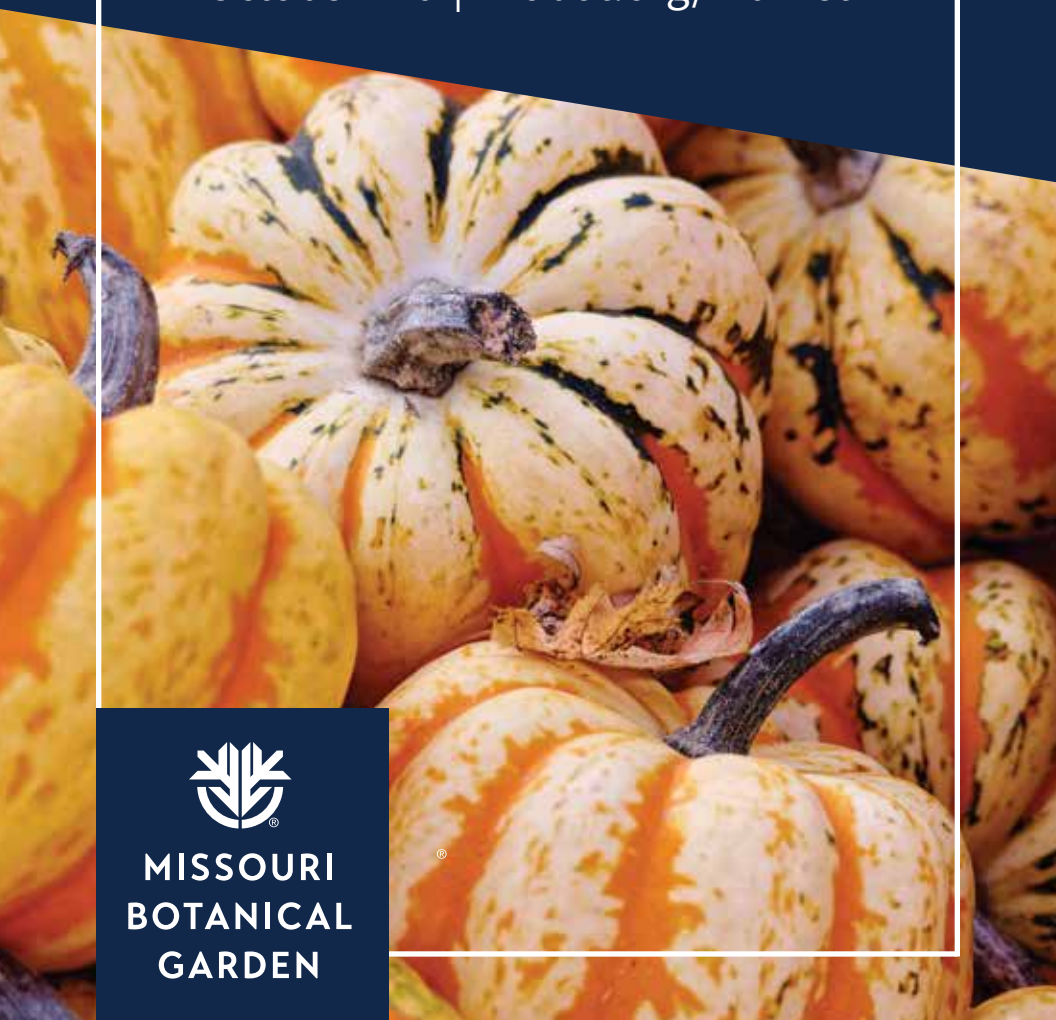

- Vendors use Certified Compostable ware for serving food and sampling.
- Beverage cans, bottles, cups, and all cardboard are recycled.
- Volunteer Zero Waste Ambassadors educate visitors at the waste stations.
- Facility support staff helps sort waste correctly to keep the Market clean.
- Recyclables are sent on to be processed into new products.
- Collected food and serving waste is composted into nutrient-rich soil amendments at a local facility.
